



Alsbury Mission Trip

GUATEMALA

- WHO:** Any student or adult (must be at least 12 years old)
Suggested middle school age students have a parent accompany them
- WHAT:** International Mission Trip
- WHEN:** June 17-23
- WHERE:** Eagle's Nest Orphanage – Solola, Guatemala
- COST:** *Total cost approximately \$1000*
\$400 (includes all meals, lodging) + airfare (expected to be about \$550)
- DEADLINE:** Registration and \$100 non-refundable deposit due by December 16.

Why Guatemala?

To ENGAGE our world with the Love of God by actively participating in missional efforts across the street and around the world.

Will We Be Safe?

We will be staying in cabins on-site within the security of the orphanage complex. Friends of Alsbury, Terry and Tiffany McConnell now live and work at Eagle's Nest Orphanage and helping to coordinate this trip. Eagle's Nest hosts multiple groups from America throughout the year and have never had any incident.

What Will We Do?

We will be helping with maintenance projects around the facilities like painting and light construction work. We will also be helping with the children who stay at the orphanage and participating in their school structure. Each afternoon we will do a community outreach to the children in the surrounding area similar to a miniature vacation bible school.

But The Cost???

I understand that the cost might be prohibitive for some, but please do not let money be the deciding factor in your student not going. If your student really wants to go, we will work with you to help provide some of the funds. Fundraising opportunities will be available to help earn money toward this trip in the spring semester.

What Preparations Will Be Required?

We will hold 4 trainings the third Sunday evening of each month for February, March, April, and May. Everyone participating in the mission trip will be required to attend these training meetings.

A passport will be required of everyone participating.

There are no specific shots required, but immunizations should be up to date. Though not required, the CDC does recommend Hep A & B shots.

Any participant 18 years or older will be required to have a background check completed.
